



**PREPARING THE CAR TO MOVE AWAY.** On a straight and level road.

**SAFETY CHECKS TO MAKE BEFORE STARTING THE ENGINE!**

- 1/ Check that the handbrake is on.
- 2/ Check that the gearstick is in neutral.
- 3/ a) Put the key into the ignition switch on the right of the steering column. Turn the key away from you once to release the steering lock if it is on. (Gently turn the steering wheel to the right whilst turning the key to release the lock.
- 3/ b) Turn the key a second time and the information on the dashboard will be displayed.
- 3/ c) Turn the key a third time and release the key immediately once the engine starts.



## MOVING AWAY

REMEMBER..... **P. O. M.** and **M.S.M./ P.S.L.**

**Preparation.** Hand Brake on. Gear stick in Neutral.

Clutch in, (LEFT FOOT) Select first gear, Set the gas, (Right foot). Revs should be roughly double the tick over speed.

SLOWLY and GENTLY release the foot off the clutch pedal, listen for the tone of the engine change, the vehicle "Tighten up" and the bonnet lift slightly as the clutch bites.

KEEP YOUR FEET **STILL**

**Observation.** **SIX** point check all around

1/ Left blind spot	3/ ahead	5/ right door mirror
2/ left door mirror	4/ centre mirror	6/ Right blind spot

Are there any eyes on us?



If there are any vehicles or pedestrians that will be affected by our manoeuvre. Then a signal is required!!

### **Manoeuvre**

As you bring your head back to look ahead, release the handbrake. The car will begin to move slowly forward as you **slowly** and **gently** release the clutch.

Add a tiny (Thickness of a pound coin) bit more gas.

To take up the normal driving position (1 metre away from the kerb) turn the steering wheel from "12 o'clock position to 5 mins past, once the car is in the driving position, turn the wheel back to 5 mins to the hour and then back to "12" to straighten the wheels.

Maintain speed and check centre mirror. If other vehicles wish to overtake, maintain your speed and position and let them go by.
